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**Question (1)**

- a) Explain Three (03) of Internal factors that influence the process of business enterprises. (6 Marks)

- d) How does the purchase of a new laundry machine affect the profit and loss statement? (5 Marks)
- e) Explain what is meant by tangible asset and Intangible Assets. (4 Marks)

**Question (2)**

- a) Enter the following transactions in the three-column cash book of Aura Travel Agency. Balance off the cash book and show the discounts accounts in the general ledger. (12 Marks)

- 1<sup>st</sup> July Balances brought forward: Cash Rs:29,300 ; Bank Rs :44,210.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> July Cash sales Rs: 4550.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> July The following debtors paid their accounts by cheque each deducting a 5% cash discount: Ruvin Peiris Rs 2460, Malith Rs : 1620 and Romesh Rs: 2530.
- 4<sup>th</sup> July Paid Rent by cheque Rs: 7500.
- 4<sup>th</sup> July Cash Sales Rs: 8500
- 5<sup>th</sup> July Paid wages by cheque Rs:11,600.
- 6<sup>th</sup> July Paid the following accounts by cheque, in each case deducting a 2% cash discount: Kalum Rs :2300, David Rs: 2100, Kamil Rs: 3250
- 7<sup>th</sup> July Transferred Rs: 2500 cash to the bank account.
- 8<sup>th</sup> July Bought stationery Rs : 2160, paying cash.
- 8<sup>th</sup> July paid electricity charges Rs : 42700

- b) Record the following particulars and prepare a Petty Cash Book under the petty Cash Imprest System. All transactions start from 2018. (10 Marks)

- Jan. 1. Received from the Chief Cashier as imprest cash Rs :12000.
- Jan. 2. Paid Taxi hire Rs : 220.
- Jan. 3. Purchase sanitary items Rs : 425.
- Jan. 3. Paid postage Rs:1128 and Envelopes Rs : 240.
- Jan. 4. Purchased stationery Rs: 550.
- Jan. 5. Paid telegram charges Rs: 450. and bus fare Rs: 230.
- Jan. 6. Paid Clearing charges Rs : 600.
- Jan. 7. Paid Rs: 440 for repairs of typewriter.
- Jan. 8. Sundry Expenses Rs : 1300.

- c) Explain what is meant by pretty cash imprest system. (3 Marks)

**Question (3)**

(a). "Control accounts are most commonly used for detecting errors in accounting records" Explain this statement. (5 Marks)

(b). Ajith Perera is an owner of a DAK Restaurant, operates in Colombo city, and has received his bank statement for the year to 30th September 2017. At the date, his balance at the bank amounted to Rs:14,130 whereas his own cash book showed a balance of Rs:20,000. His accountant investigated the matter, and discovered the following discrepancies:

- Ajith had brought down his opening cash book balance of Rs: 6,585 as a debit balance instead of as a credit balance.
- Ajith had entered a payment of Rs:560 in his cash book as Rs: 650.
- Bank Service Charges Rs: 450.
- Standing order to Pay Rent Rs : 5000
- Cheques drawn by Ajith to settle the electricity charges in August Rs:1200. had not been presented to the bank.
- One of Ajith's customers had agreed to settle their debts Rs: 450 by direct debit though nothing was entered in the cash books yet. Unfortunately, the bank had credited the direct debit to another customer's account.

Required to prepare:

- a) Make any necessary entries in the cash book as at 30 September 2017.
- b) Prepare a Bank Reconciliation statement as at 30 September 2017.
