- 04. Do you think that the public policies of successive governments of Sri Lanka were not met with the political and economic aspirations of Sinhala youth in the South? Explain your answer with the experience of 1971 and 1988-89 insurrections of JVP.

"Since independence, the discriminatory policies introduced by the government of Sri Lanka led the Tamil youth in the North-East region of the country to took up arms and struggled for carving out a separate state." Discuss this statement with the appropriate examples as the root causes of the decade long civil war in the country.

 - b) Major impacts of Open Economic Policy of 1978
 - c) Peoples' struggle of 2022 over the economic crises
