- 02. Do you agree that in *Nineteen Eighty-Four* the ultimate goal of the State is the eradication of all semblances of humanity? Discuss with close reference to the novel.

### Part B

- 03. "As much as Okonkwo's cosmos is self-made, its collapse also depends entirely on its creator." Critically examine this statement in relation to Chinua Achebe's *Things Fall Apart*.
- 04. Do you agree that the colonial practices portrayed in *Things Fall Apart* are profoundly bound to the concept of land? Discuss with close reference to Chinua Achebe's *Things Fall Apart*.
- 05. "Both Antoinette and Rochester are simultaneously attracted to and alienated by the Caribbean landscape they encounter." Critically examine this statement in relation to Jean Rhys' *Wide Sargasso Sea*.
- 06. Critically examine Jean Rhys' portrayal of 'blackness' in Wide Sargasso Sea.
