2. "The truly decisive winner is the aristocratic ideal of manhood whereby a man can compete with and still be brother, son, and/or father to other men". Do you agree with this assessment of Chaucer's *The Knight's Tale*? Discuss.

PART B

Either

3. "[V]iolence stems more from the world of learning ... than from matrimony and its structures". Discuss the relationship between "reading and beating" in Chaucer's *The Wife of Bath's Prologue*.

4. Critically examine the portrayal of justice for sexual violence in Chaucer's *The Wife of Bath's Tale*.
