3. "Research on early metalinguistic development is linked to literacy development at all levels, beginning with phonological awareness and the learning of sound-letter correspondences (Chaney, 1992; Dreher & Zenge, 1990). Exposure to at least two languages from an early age has demonstrated that bilingual children display more advanced metalinguistic awareness than monolingual children".
